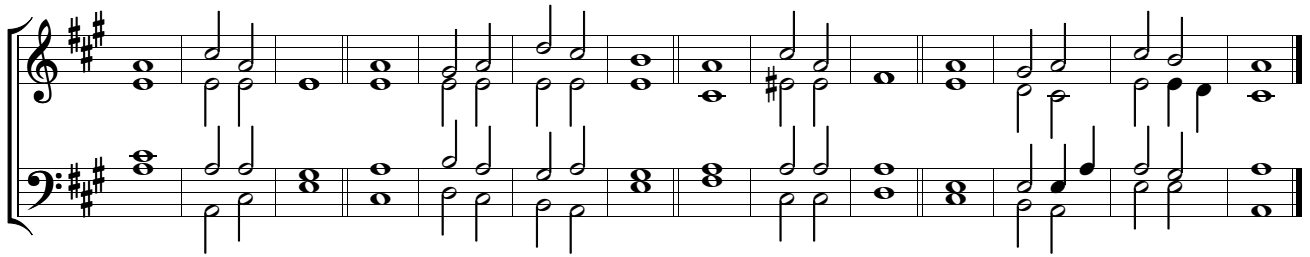


# Psalm 118, vv 14-29 Common Worship

14 The Lord is my strength and my song, and he has be - come my sal - vation.

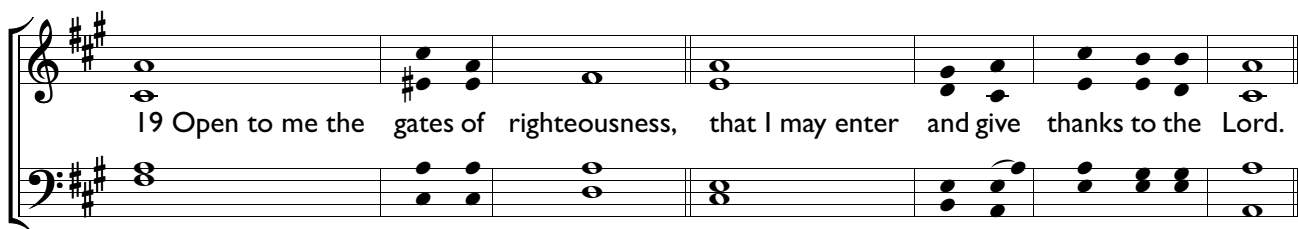
15 Joyful shouts of sal - va - tion sound from the tents of the righteous:

16 'The right hand of the Lord does mighty deeds; the right hand of the Lord rais-es up;

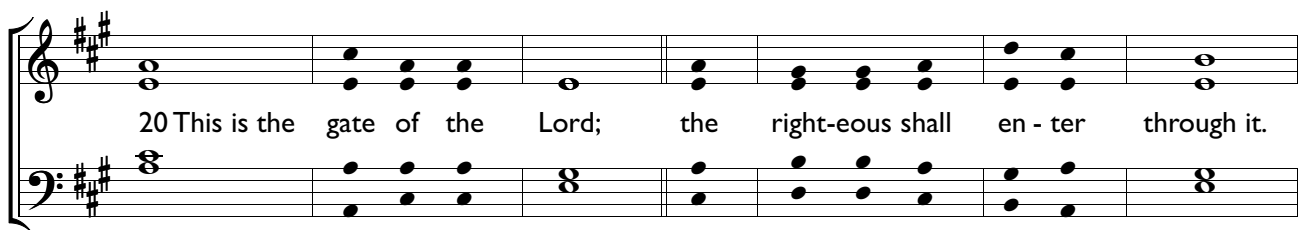
the right hand of the Lord does might-y deeds.'

17 I shall not die, but live and de - clare the works of the Lord.

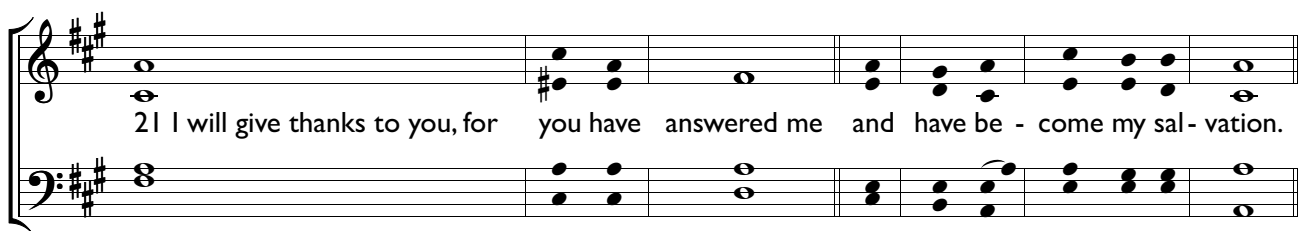
18 The Lord has pun-ished me sorely, but he has not giv-en me ov-er to death.



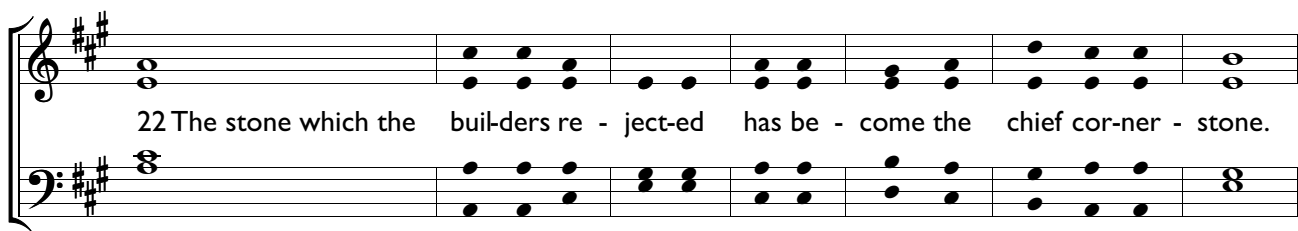
19 Open to me the gates of righteousness, that I may enter and give thanks to the Lord.



20 This is the gate of the Lord; the right-eous shall en - ter through it.



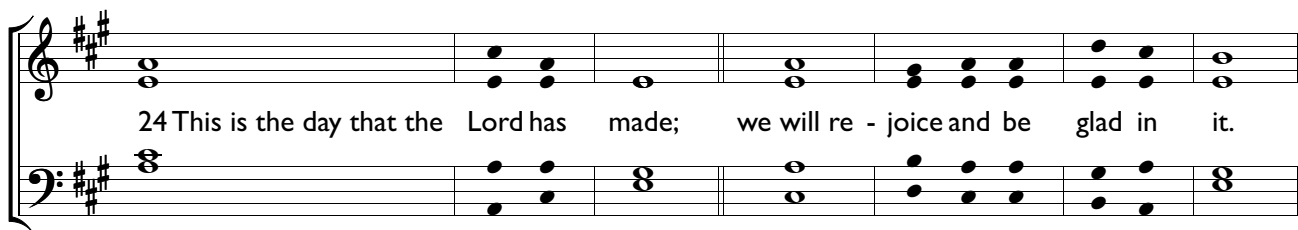
21 I will give thanks to you, for you have answered me and have be - come my sal - vation.



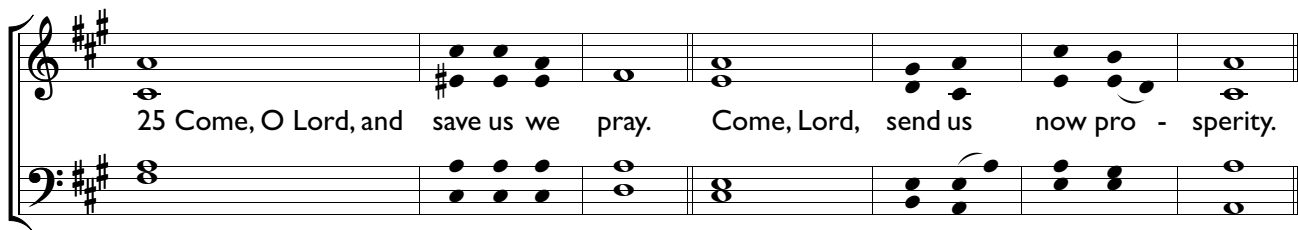
22 The stone which the build-ers re - ject-ed has be - come the chief cor-ner - stone.
